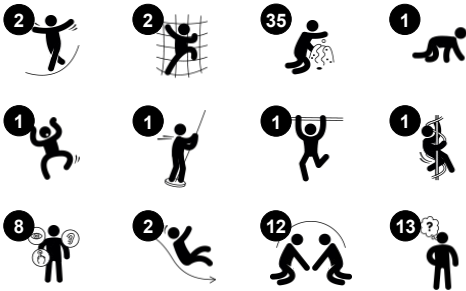

The bubble window in the tunnel bridge distorts voices when spoken into, evoking a sense of wonder and training logical thinking. Sliding down the slide or curly climber to the ground supports posture and balance, all important skills for young children, and great fun! There

are varied levels of play challenges in the accesses as well as egresses. This means fun training of life skills for all.

Curly climber

Physical: coordination and proprioception are supported when placing arms and legs correctly for going down. Sense of balance when rotating. Arm muscles for holding tight. **Social-Emotional:** empathy stimulated by turn-taking. **Cognitive:** logical thinking when placing arms and legs right for rotating downwards.



Rock climber

Physical: supports cross coordination and leg, arm and hand strength. **Social-Emotional:** the inclination makes climbing feel secure, especially for younger children.



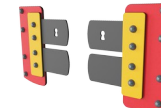
Xylophone music panel

Social-Emotional: invites social interaction and co-creation for more children, on both sides. **Cognitive:** understanding of cause and effect when striking tubes and creating sound. **Creative:** the creation of different intensity and tonality stimulates creative skills.



Bubble Tunnel

Physical: the children crawl through the tunnel, developing motor skills such as cross-body coordination and proprioception. **Social-Emotional:** turn-taking when passing each other. **Cognitive:** distorts the sound of the voice, developing logical thinking.



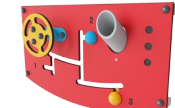
Flap door

Physical: tactile stimulation from leaning the body through rubber doors. **Cognitive:** suggests a theme and supports dramatic play, which stimulates language and communication skills.



Slide

Physical: sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. **Social-Emotional:** empathy stimulated by turn-taking. **Cognitive:** young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down quickly.



Gearshift and tube panel

Social-Emotional: spurs group play and conversations with its two-sidedness. **Cognitive:** supports dramatic play, which stimulates language skills. Communication skills when explaining functionalities. The passing of materials through funnels supports the children's logical thinking and the understanding of object permanence. **Creative:** changing the position of the gear, leaving your mark.

Pre-galvanized inside and outside with powder coated top finish steel posts. Lead free aluminum with color anodized top finish. Greenline TexMade posts of 95% post-consumer recycled PE and textile waste.

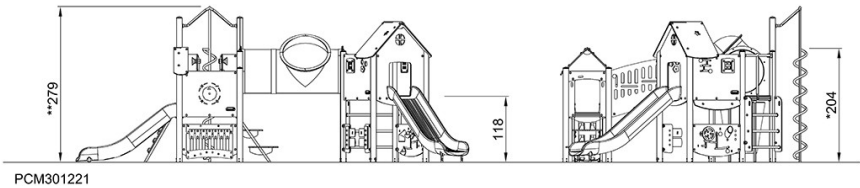
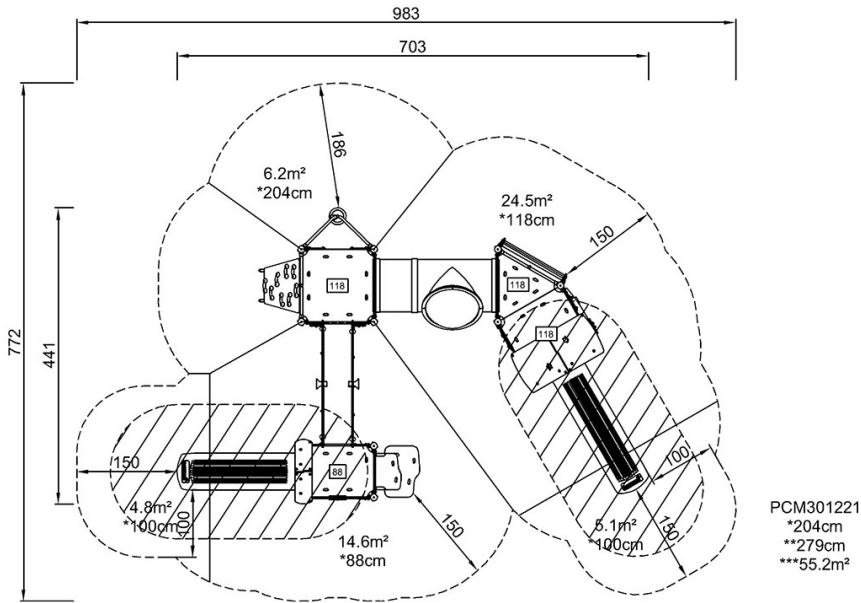
