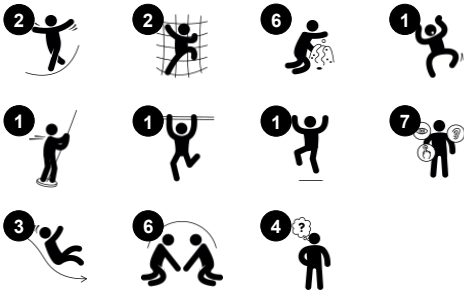

This fantastic play structure will inspire young children to play actively, using their muscles to climb to the top and slide or glide to the ground and then loop around to start again. The net climber provides an age-appropriate challenge to strengthen muscles and help develop cross-coordination skills, which support children's development across developmental domains.

For example, strengthening physical cross-coordination skills enhances children's abilities to use both sides of their brain, and supports the internal structures that enable reading and thinking. The sturdy desk on the side of the structure is a great place for meeting and interacting. With space for several children to play cooperatively, the structure supports social

skills, which are essential in the early years. The slides and pole support posture and balance, all important skills for young children as they grow, and great fun that will attract children and keep their interest in active physical play.



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Megaphone

Social-Emotional: inspires communication and turn-taking skills. **Cognitive:** distortion of sound evokes curiosity and stimulates an understanding of cause and effect.



Slide

Physical: sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. **Social-Emotional:** empathy stimulated by turn-taking. **Cognitive:** young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down quickly.



Fireman's pole

Physical: coordination is supported when going down, as well as arm and core muscles. Landing strengthens bone density, which is built for life in early childhood. **Social-Emotional:** turn-taking and risk-taking. **Cognitive:** young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when gliding down fast.



Pipe ladder

Physical: cross coordination and eye-hand coordination are supported when children climb the ladder. The climbing also supports leg and arm muscles. **Social-Emotional:** learning about turn taking and cooperation.



Climbing net

Physical: supports physical strength and cross-body coordination, which impacts coordination of the right and left part of brain, fundamental for other skills such as the ability to read.



Inclined play bridge

Physical: balance and spatial awareness are trained when walking or running up and down the bridge, changing levels. **Social-Emotional:** play spheres and holes in panels invite cooperation with children on the outside. The play spheres also stimulate parallel play. **Cognitive:** discovering and understanding spatial changes in height. **Creative:** leave a mark and place the spheres at different positions



Double slide

Physical: sliding develops spatial awareness and a sense of balance. Furthermore, the core muscles are trained when sitting upright going down. **Social-Emotional:** invites socializing, supports parent-child, peer-to-peer play and allows for caregiver assistance. **Cognitive:** young children train their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down quickly.

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Panels of 19mm EcoCore™. EcoCore™ is a highly durable, eco friendly material, which is not only recyclable after use, but also consists of material produced from +95% recycled post consumer material from food packing waste.



Main posts with hot dip galvanized steel footing are available in different materials: Pressure impregnated pine wood posts. Pre-galvanized inside and outside with powder coated top finish steel posts. Lead free aluminum with color anodized top finish. Greenline TexMade posts of 95% post-consumer recycled PE and textile waste.



All decks are supported by unique designed low-carbon aluminum profiles with multiple attachment options. The grey colored molded decks are made of 75% post-consumer waste PP material with a non-skid pattern and texture surface.



The slides can be chosen in six different colors and three materials: Straight or curved one-piece molded PE slides, made from 33% recycled post-consumer materials in different colours. Combined EcoCore™ sides and stainless-steel. Full stainless steel in one piece design for more vandalism proof solutions.



The steel surfaces are hot dip galvanised inside and outside with lead free zinc. The galvanisation has excellent corrosion resistance in outside environments and requires low maintenance.

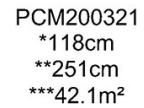
