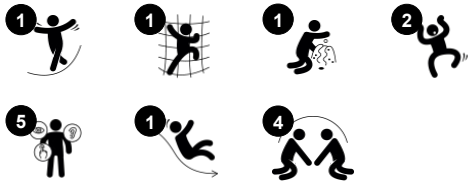

WOW! Exciting themed play that inspires and attracts children of all ages. The KOMPAN Pirate Ship inspired dramatic play, and the variation of climbing and sliding attracts endless play. In the keel, there is a nice seat for meeting. On the upper deck, a nice steering wheel spurs dramatic play and stimulates play conversation. A steel ladder leads to an

elevated level, training children's muscles and cross-coordination as they climb. The cross-coordination is important in building up the cooperation of left and right brain halves, which supports reading skills. From the upper deck, the child can slide down, full speed. This trains the sense of balance and helps the child build up and understanding of space and measures.

Physical: develops spatial awareness, sense of balance and trains core muscles when sitting upright going down. **Social-Emotional:** empathy stimulated by turn-taking. **Cognitive:** young children develop their understanding of space, speed and distances when sliding down.



Pipe ladder

Physical: cross coordination and eye-hand coordination are supported when children climb the ladder. The climbing also supports leg and arm muscles. **Social-Emotional:** learning about turn taking and cooperation.



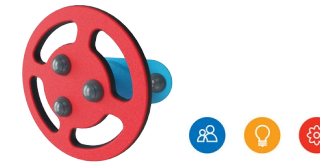
Open space in front

Social-Emotional: the bench along the keel is a great space for meeting and exchanging.



Theme

Cognitive: suggests a theme and supports dramatic play, which stimulates languages and communication skills.



Turning wheel

Social-Emotional: develops turn-taking, communication and cooperation. **Cognitive:** the manipulative item stimulates 'cause and effect' understanding, logical thinking and communication. **Creative:** working with moveable play items that can leave a mark supports the child's creativity.



Platform

Social-Emotional: courage, self-confidence, consideration and turn-taking are built when children share the platform.

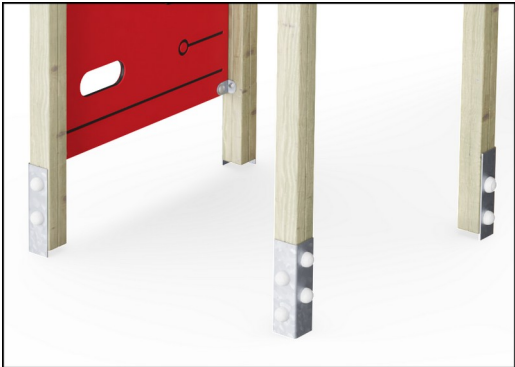
Panels of 19mm EcoCore™. EcoCore™ is a highly durable, eco-friendly material, which is not only recyclable after use but also consists of a core produced from 100% recycled material.



The main tower posts are available in two types of material: European pine wood posts pressure impregnated Class 3 with Tanalith E preservative, or aluminium with an anodised surface treatment.



Floors and panel activities are manufactured from high-pressure laminate HPL with a thickness 17.8mm and non-skid surface texture.



Slides are available in three different materials: moulded on piece PE slides, combined EcoCore™ sides and stainless steel slide bed t=2mm. Full stainless steel AISI304 t=2mm.

The main posts are equipped with hot-dip galvanised steel footings. The steel footings elevate the posts position 20mm from ground level to avoid contact with surfacing material.

Slides are available in three different materials: moulded on piece PE slides, combined EcoCore™ sides and stainless steel slide bed t=2mm. Full stainless steel AISI304 t=2mm.

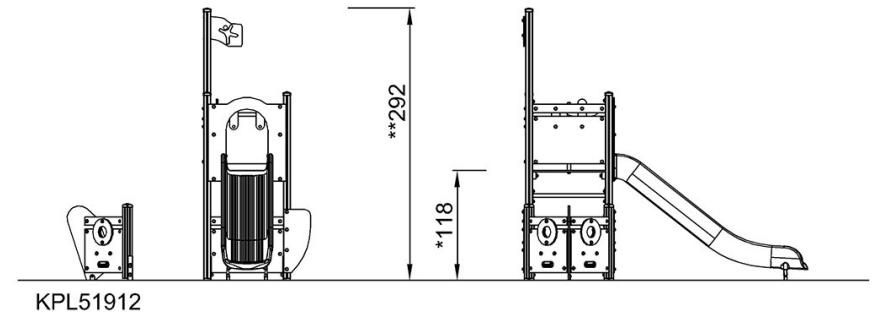
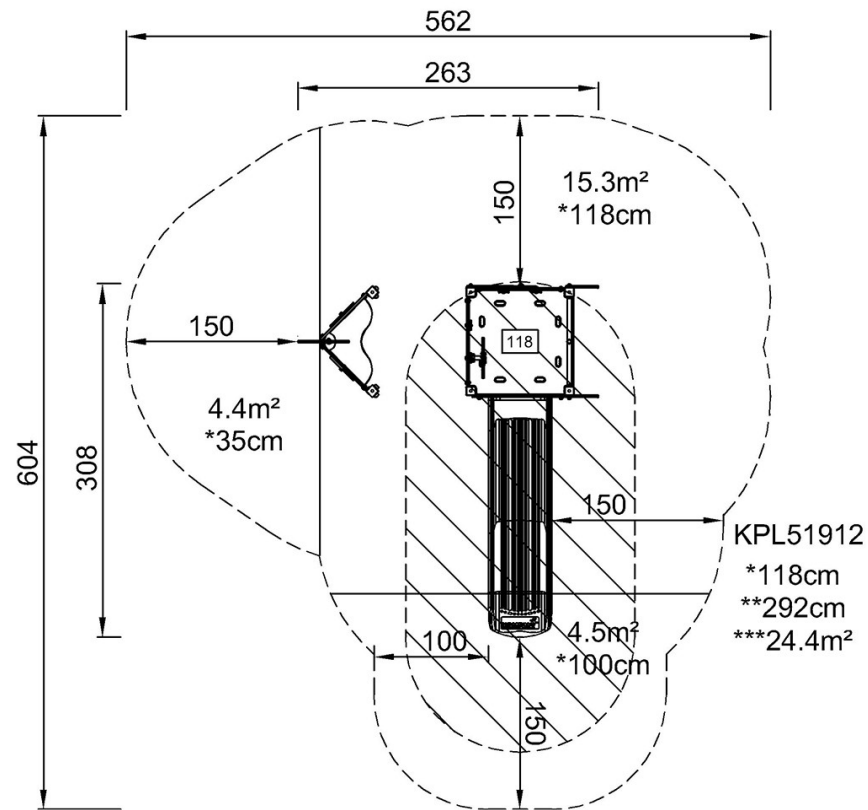
